Creating an Adobe ID and Installing Digital Editions

You'll need an Adobe ID for any OverDrive eBooks or audiobooks that are not for Kindle devices or apps. You'll need Digital Editions to read non-Kindle eBooks on your laptop or sideload onto your eReader. You only have to do this once per computer, but you can authorize (or add) up to 6 computers & 6 mobile devices to your Adobe account.

Adobe Digital Editions

Step 1 - Create a free account with Adobe

- Go to <http://adobe.ly/newadobeid>.
- Click '**Don't have an Adobe ID**' to get started.
- Fill in the form.
- Remove the check in the box for '**Stay informed via email about Adobe products and services**' if you do not wish to have Adobe contact you.
- Click '**Create**'. You now have your Adobe ID. Adobe may ask you for more information. You can provide it if you want but it is not necessary. You will receive a confirmation e-mail soon.

Step 2 - Download and install Adobe Digital Editions

- Go to <http://www.adobe.ly/deditions>.
- Find the '**Download Now**' link.
- Select your operating system.
- Follow the prompts, clicking '**Yes**', '**Next**' and '**Install**' when appropriate.
(Adobe Digital Editions should open automatically when the download and installation is complete.)
- Click '**I agree**' to accept the terms of use for your computer.
- Click '**Continue**'.
- When prompted, authorize your computer by supplying the Adobe ID and password that you created in Step 1.

Step 3 - Find and download a book

- Go to <http://prl.lib.overdrive.com> and browse or search for an eBook you want.
- Click '**Borrow**'.
- Enter your library card number.
- Click the '**Download**' button.
- Select **EPUB eBook**.
- Click on '**Confirm & Download**' to download the book to your computer.
- If prompted, choose to open the file. Adobe Digital Editions will open automatically when the book is done downloading.

Step 4 - Transfer the book to your eReader

- Connect your eReader to your computer. A link for your eReader will be displayed in the left column of Adobe Digital Editions. (The first time you use a new device with Adobe Digital Editions, you will be prompted to 'authorize' it. If prompted, follow the instructions on your screen, using the Adobe ID created above.)
- Click on the eBook you want to transfer.
- Drag and drop the eBook to the link for your eReader under '**Devices**' to transfer the eBook to your eReader.
- Disconnect your eReader.

Note: if you are using a Nook eReader, your eBook will show up in '**My Documents**' or '**My Files**'.

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
